Jars of Clay is a non-profit outreach and Christian church dedicated to helping the inner-city poor, specifically in the Pittsburgh neighborhood of Atlanta. Jars of Clay provides hope, shelter, food, clothing, life rehabilitation, education, job training and biblical training to hundreds of children, adults and families each month.

Jars of Clay also offers shelter for both day and night. For only \$10 a day a family can remain safe and be in an environment that will empower them to reach for success.

The day program is geared to help people who truly want to help themselves. People who attend the day program are seeking refuge from the streets and have nowhere to rest for the day. They are usually serious about ending their homelessness and are grateful for a warm, clean facility to help them become grounded again. The night shelter program can house more than 80 people per night. Most find Jars of Clay's innovative programs such as job search, resume preparation, life coaching, clothing, soup kitchen and counseling incredibly beneficial.
